Thank you for your invitation to reciprocate privileges between our sailing clubs. Our Board of Directors has met on 2017-04-10 and has unanimously approved the reciprocity of privileges between our clubs for the 2017 season.

Your membership card will enable you to access our facilities, including showers and washrooms in our capitainerie (Club House), a pumpout service dock, and a second service dock equipped with a manually-operated crane designed for stepping and unstepping masts. There are also public facilities, such as a launching ramp, a restaurant, and public mooring slips, which are available for free during the day and for a nominal fee at night (subject to availability).

A note that may be of importance to your members concerns the marina's access channel: Although the depth of the channel is still limited in some areas by bedrock, practically all of the large rocks along its length have been removed, which increases the navigability considerably. The depth of the channel at its shallowest location is approximately 6.5 feet at Chart Datum, and this area is of very limited extent. We would be grateful if you could advise your members of this fact. If in doubt your members should call the capitainerie by telephone at (819)-682-2847.
